Faith Covenant Corporate Fasting & Prayer Guide for 3-27-25 to 3-30-25

During this voluntary corporate fasting and prayer time we are humbling ourselves, seeking God for clarity regarding opportunities before us, and asking for protection and victory as we move forward in faith. We will take time reflecting upon our thoughts, feelings, and actions in light of the written and revealed Word of God. Acknowledge, confess, and repent of sin, asking the Lord to help us to see Him and to see ourselves more clearly with a view towards constant submission and swift obedience to the Holy Spirit in all things.

Focus #1: Humility

Exodus 10:3 (NASB95) Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and said to him, "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews, 'How long will you refuse to humble yourself before Me?...

<u>James 1:21</u> (NAS95) Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls.

<u>2 Corinthians 10:5</u> (NASB95) We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ,

<u>Proverbs 22:4</u> (NASB95) *The reward of humility and the fear of the LORD Are riches, honor and life.*

Focus #2: Clarity

<u>Isaiah 30:21</u> (NASB95) Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right or to the left.

<u>1 Corinthians 13:12</u> (NASB95) For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I will know fully just as I also have been fully known.

Ephesians 1:9-10 NASB95) He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His kind intention which He purposed in Him ¹⁰ with a view to an administration suitable to the fullness of the times, that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth.

<u>Proverbs 3:5-6</u> (NASB95) *Trust in the LORD with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding.* ⁶*In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He will make your paths straight.*

Focus #3: Provision and Protection

2 Corinthians 9:8-10 (NASB95) And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed; ⁹as it is written, "HE SCATTERED ABROAD, HE GAVE TO THE POOR, HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS ENDURES FOREVER." ¹⁰Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness;

<u>Psalms 91:14-16</u> (NASB95) "Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him securely on high, because he has known My name. ¹⁵"He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him. ¹⁶"With a long life I will satisfy him And let him see My salvation."
